

Home Learning

Home Learning will provide weekly activities to enhance your child's learning. These activities offer personalisation and choice to your family. There is no obligation to complete the activities, however, we would strongly recommend your child engages with them, in particular spelling and reading tasks.

All pupils will be provided with a Home Learning jotter. The Home Learning jotter will be updated weekly and should go between school and home on a daily basis. Pupils will be encouraged to use their Home Learning jotter to practise their work at home. Pupils may wish to share their work with their class teacher, however, it will not be marked. When pupils have completed their Home Learning jotter they may return it to school for another to be issued.

Spelling

Spelling words and 'Phonemes of the Week' will be provided weekly and placed inside your child's Home Learning jotter. Spelling words will be grouped appropriately and your child will only have access to their own spelling words. A spelling grid will be placed inside the Home Learning jotter, suggesting creative ways in which your child can practise their spelling words. Please help your child by practising these words at home. Weekly spelling tests will be recorded at the back of your child's Home Learning jotter. Please remember to ask your child on a Friday whether their hard work paid off!

Termly Overviews

Termly Overviews will be added termly in your child's Home Learning jotter. These provide information as to what your child is learning in class, in order for you to support them at home.

Reading

Reading books will be issued on a regular basis depending on your child's stage. Primary 1-3 pupils will receive books on a weekly basis. Primary 4-7 pupils will receive books over a longer period of time. Bookmarks will be inside your child's reading book to indicate the Home Learning for the week. Reading books should be available in school every day.

Guided Reading and Talking Point activity sheets for P2-7 are optional activities which will be emailed out at the beginning of each term. Current reading books can be used to complete these tasks. These resources will be updated termly in the Home Learning jotter.

Linguascope

Linguascope is a website children can use to learn and practise foreign language vocabulary. Your child's username and password is in the Home Learning jotter.

Numeracy

Sumdog is an online maths practice tool that provides games based learning to reinforce numeracy concepts. Class teachers will update Sumdog termly to provide games which consolidate numeracy topics taught in class. Each child has a username and password which can be found in the Home Learning jotter.

GLOW

GLOW is Scotland's nationally available digital environment that can be used to support learning across the curriculum. Pupil's GLOW usernames will be in the front of the Home Learning jotter, however passwords will not be included as these are private. Class teachers will share these.
